Open Container Ordinance

Ordinances relating to conduct and activities on Town property and further relating to activities within the Town of WHITEFIELD, New Hampshire.

The Selectboard of the Town of WHITEFIELD does hereby promulgate and enact the following ordinances;

- 1) There shall be no open containers of alcoholic beverages in ANY public place within the Town of WHITEFIELD. Ordinance shall not prohibit nor supersede the Board of Selectmen's authority to issue permits for the use and consumption of alcoholic beverages in or on properties owned by the Town of WHITEFIELD. Public place shall include but not be limited to; highways, streets, roads, sidewalks, parks, playgrounds, beaches used for recreational purposes, and other similar locations.
 - a) Any violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$155.00
 - b) Any subsequent violation of this ordinance within 12 calendar months of the first violation shall be subject to a fine of \$200,00

Unnecessary Noise Ordinance

No vehicle shall be operated within the Town of WHITEFIELD in such a manner as to create the spinning of tires, or an excessively noisy or disruptive manner. This shall include the over revving of a vehicles' motor in the event of rapid and unnecessary acceleration. No person shall operate a vehicle within the Town of WHITEFIELD so that the lives and safety of any person may be at risk.

a) Any violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and no more than \$1000.00
