PARKING

ORDINANCES

In the interest of of public safety and welfare, the town of Whitefield in accordance with RSA 41:11(47:17(XV111)), promulgates the following ordinance, as it relates to the use of all public and private roads, ways, alleyways, driveways and parking areas in the Town of Whitefield.

- I. It shall be unlawful to park in any area designated as RESTRICTED or NO PARKING ZONE be it a town or private way.
 - 2. It shall be unlawful to stop, park or block any alleyway, driveway. parking slot. (Public or private), in the Town of Whitefield.
 - 3. It shall be unlawful to park within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
 - 4. It shall be unlawful to park on any sidewalk or crosswalk.
 - 5. It shall be unlawful to park on any town street during posted dates and times during the Winter Parking Ban
 - 6. It shall be unlawful to park in any place (Public or private) which is specifically designated for the use of the handicapped by means of a sign stating the space is reserved for the physically handicapped or displaying the wheelchair symbol painted on the ground surface.
 - 7. No vehicle shall be stopped or parked so as to constitute double parking except to load or unload passengers or deliveries.
 - 8. It is unlawful to allow any vehicle to stop, stand or park on any public or private way unless there is sufficient space remaining for any other vehicle to pass in safety. (Fire truck, ambulance or any other emergency vehicle).
- II. Regulatory signs and markings are to be installed by, or under the authority of the Town of Whitefield Police Department.
- III. Except as such may be altered by the foregoing, the provisions of RSA 265:68, RSA 265:69 and RSA 265:71 shall also apply.

IV. PENALTIES

WINTER PARKING BAN	\$25.00
FIRE HYDRANT	\$25.00
All OTHER VIOLATIONS	\$25.00

- A. All fines must be paid within 30 calendar days.
- B. Any person who fails to pay such fines shall be notified by certified mail of such violation: That person then bas 5 business days from the date of delivery of such notification to pay all such fines.
- C. Any person still in violation of this section after being duly notified by registered mail, shall be subject to a summons to the 1st Circuit Court and may be fined not more than \$1,000.00 per violation under RSA 31.39.

APPEALS

A. Any person who wishes to appeal a parking ticket may do so within 5 business days of the date of issue. Appeals should be dated, in written form, signed by the person filing the appeal, and directed to;

This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption by the Board of Selectmen, posting in two public places, and upon recording an attested copy of same with the Whitefield Town Clerk.
